BOARD OF DIRECTORS MEETING
Tuesday, November 16th, 2021**

MINUTES

The Board of Directors of the Criminal Justice Coordinating Council held its scheduled meeting on November 16th, 2021 at 9:48 am during the CJCC 2021 Board Retreat.

MINUTES

Mr. Csonka reviewed the minutes from the Board of Directors Meeting held on November 16th, 2021. **On a motion by Mr. Darry Gissel and a second by Judge Gail Grover, the Board of Directors unanimously approved the minutes of the Board of Directors Meeting held on September 23, 2021.**

Mr. Csonka requested the Board members consider creating a data subcommittee under the CJCC that would consist of representatives from all the justice agencies that will focus on establishing a justice data warehouse within the CJCC. The purpose of the data warehouse would be to combine data from all the different justice agencies to be used to create public-facing dashboards as well as presenting data to justice stakeholders to be used to more effectively and efficiently manage their respective organization. **On a motion by Judge Gail Grover and a second by Mr. Darryl Gissel, the Board of Directors unanimously approved the motion to create a data subcommittee and hold CJCC Board Meetings on a quarterly basis.**

Mr. Csonka also asked the Board members if they would like to keep holding bi-monthly meetings or change to quarterly meetings for 2022. The Board members present indicated they want the CJCC Board meeting to remain scheduled on a bi-monthly basis.
